


Meet the Buyer Event Eastern Green Link 2, Goole

We are inviting local businesses to learn about potential supply chain opportunities with the Eastern Green Link 2 project in the North Yorkshire and Humber region. The project is a joint venture between SSEN Transmission and National Grid Electricity Transmission, in collaboration with our preferred contractors Hitachi Energy and BAM Nuttall.

Work for Eastern Green Link 2 is due to commence in 2024. Subsea cabling, underground cabling and a new converter station will be developed as part of the project. After travelling 440km under the sea from Peterhead, a subsea cable will come ashore at Wilsthorpe, just south of Bridlington. A cable will then run underground onshore for around 70km, to a new converter station and existing substation at Drax, North Yorkshire.



This project has the potential to create local business opportunities in the following sectors:
