I acknowledge receipt of your letter, reference SEGL2/00114 dates 11th September 2023, and the enclosed documentation providing more detailed information relating to the proposed SGEL2 Project. The proposed access route from Newsholme is unacceptable and I will, formally register my objection to this part of the plan with the Secretary of State.

,Following communications with your agents Fisher German LLP, It was my understanding that;
(a) there was no longer any requirement to acquire any rights over the property known as Beechtree Farm, Newsholme and

(b) that Footpath number 6 running around the North boundary of Beechtree farm would not be used as an access route.

A letter confirming this understanding was sent to Mr Oliver Rudd at Fisher German on the 8th March 2023, a copy is enclosed for information.

With reference to the documents and plans enclosed with your letter. In particular CPO Land Plan Sheet 5 of 46, plot numbers 5/218, 5/218a, 5/218b, 5/221. 5/221a, 5/222, 5/223 and 5/224, your project plan still includes a proposal to use the village of Newsholme as an access route and to develop footpath number 6 to a road for construction traffic.

My objection to this access route is based on the following:

- poor access to the village of Newsholme from the A36 main road. This is a straight, narrow road with a high volume of fast moving traffic, any vehicle travelling west to enter Newsholme will need to stop blocking the west bound carriageway creating the potential for rear end collisions.
- The loop road through Newsholme is designated as "UNSUITABLE FOR HEAVY COODS VEHICLES"
- · the loop road through newsholme is a narrow single vehicle width road, there are no
