

## Upcoming works at Wren Hall – Spring 2025

As a neighbour of our project area, we are writing to update you on upcoming works related to the Eastern Green Link 2 (EGL2) project at our Wren Hall Converter Station site in Drax.

### Piling works

In the week commencing **Monday 7 April 2025**, we will be starting piling activities that will last approximately four to six weeks. Piling is the process of driving pre-made thin concrete elements into the ground beneath the location where a structure is going to be constructed to form its foundation, helping to support it and ensuring stability.

### Construction traffic management

Deliveries for stone (aggregate) to build the platforms for our construction compound and converter station platforms have been underway since **November 2024**. These deliveries will increase as work progresses and we expect the peak of vehicle movements to occur in **April 2025**, remaining high throughout **Summer 2025**. As part of these works, the size of the delivery HGVs will also increase to accommodate the ongoing works.

We have worked with local council representatives and officials to implement a robust Construction Traffic Management Plan to minimise disruption and reduce impact on the local road network.

### Traffic management on Wren hall Lane

To support essential utility connections at our Wren Hall Converter Station site, temporary traffic management will be in place along Wren Hall Lane. These measures will be overseen by the Northern Powergrid to ensure safety and minimise disruption.

Please see the works to be carried out:

Works operator	Works needed	Measures in place	Expected timings
Northern Powergrid	To facilitate new power connection	Road closure on Wren Hall Lane	Monday 7 April – Monday 16 June 2025

Please be aware that these traffic signals will manage traffic flow continuously during these periods to ensure the work proceeds safely and efficiently.

We also expect to close a lane on New Road for a short time in early April to allow for surfacing work at our site entrance.

**As you may already be aware, we are currently in the process of constructing a new converter station at Wren Hall as part of the EGL2 project.**
