

Wren Hall piling works – March/April 2026

As a neighbour of our Wren Hall Converter Station site in Drax, we're writing to update you on upcoming works for the Eastern Green Link 2 (EGL2) project.

Piling works

The final phase of piling will restart on **Monday 2 March** and is scheduled to be completed by **Friday 24 April**.

This accelerated piling programme is to ensure the works are carried out as quickly and efficiently as possible to minimise disruption.

Work will take place:

- **Monday to Friday, 7am to 7pm**
- **Occasionally on Saturdays, 8am to 5pm, if required**

There will be no work over the Easter weekend. The site will be closed from **Friday 3 April to Monday 6 April**, with no piling or other construction activity taking place.

Thank you for your continued patience while we complete this important stage of works to build the converter station foundations.
