

Enabling works north of Camblesforth – December 2025

Eastern Green Link 2 (EGL2) is one of the most significant strategic energy infrastructure developments the UK has seen in recent years, connecting the north of Scotland to Yorkshire via the sea.

In order to facilitate this significant upgrade to the network, we will be carrying out works on the existing 400 kV overhead line between Drax Substation and Eggborough Substation.

We are writing to inform you that we are carrying out vegetation clearance north of Camblesforth ahead of our main upgrade works programme early in 2026. This vegetation clearance will create the space needed to install scaffolding and to access the overhead lines to carry out our essential upgrades.

EGL2 is a 505km electricity superhighway which will connect a new converter station in Drax, North Yorkshire to Peterhead in Aberdeenshire via a subsea cable.

To enable the vegetation clearance to be completed, a road closure will be in place along a section of Chestercourt Lane. This road closure is expected to be in place from **Monday 1 December to Friday 5 December 2025**.
